- Troubleshooting physical problems and addressing issues within the facility
- Working on trouble and support tickets
- Monitoring and maintenance of the data centre infrastructure

Previous experience is not necessary since full training can be provided. However, you must have good knowledge of, and demonstrable interest in, PC and server hardware and be hugely passionate about technology. You will also need to have a full, clean UK driving licence.

Due to the nature of the position, you must be able to lift at least 15kg (33lb) over head, be happy to work as part of an on-call rota, and willing to work overtime when required.
